DAY CARE GUIDELINES

1. **Day Care Hours: 6:45 A.M. - 8:00 A.M. AND 3:00 P.M. - 5:45 P.M.**
(The janitor IS NOT a Day care Worker and cannot be expected to watch children)

Day Care Grace Period:

No day care charges are incurred between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.

2. **Day Care Charges:**

\$3.50 per hour per child (charged in 15 minute increments)

\$2.00 PER MINUTE PER CHILD WILL BE CHARGED BEFORE 6:45 A.M. & AFTER 5:45 P.M.

3. Day Care Charges are for students in Extended Day Care, Study Hall, Sports Programs, or any other activities and are on the campus rather than at the scheduled practices.
4. Parents will be billed the beginning of each month for Day Care charges.
(i.e. September day care charges will be billed in October)
5. You must sign in your child **EACH MORNING AND SIGN OUT EACH AFTERNOON.**
This is necessary so you will not be charged for time your child is not in Day Care. It is also important so that the school staff will know who is on campus and who has left campus. Please note on the sign-in and sign-out sheet if your child has been at any sports practices, detention or any other activity on the campus. If you have more than one child and you pick them up at separate times, please note what time each child is picked up on the sign-out sheets.
If your child leaves the playground in the afternoon without signing out, you can be charged until 5:45 p.m.
6. If you have a conference with a teacher, an appointment in the office, or any other business on the campus and you leave your child in the care of the Day Care staff, Day care charges will occur.
Keep your child with you to avoid these charges being applied to your account.
7. If a child is involved with organized sports on campus and on a scheduled practice day does not go to practice, there will be a Day Care charge. If practices are dismissed early (i.e., practice is scheduled from 3:00 P.M. to 4:30 P.M. but practice is completed by 4:00 p.m. per the coach) there is no charge until 4:30 P.M.. There will be a charge beginning at 4:30 P.M.. You must still sign your child out of EDC, however, be sure to note that your child was at practice.
8. Students on the campus before 8:00 A.M. or after 3:00 P.M. will be placed on Day Care at the rate of \$3.50 per hour, per child.
9. If there is a dispute regarding Day care charges applied to your bill, please put your comments in writing and submit it to the school office.

School Uniform Dress Code Policy

Any student out of uniform will be sent to the office to call his/her parents. Parents will be expected to bring proper clothing to the school. Uniforms can only be purchased through Nunes Uniform Company. No other uniforms will be allowed. All items of clothing will have the Nunes label. The Hueneme Christian School Uniform Policy is as follows:

GIRLS:

Skirts, Jumpers or Skorts: (Nunes Uniform Company only)

Khaki tan color or Plaid jumper/skirt.
Length should be 3-5 inches from the floor, when kneeling.

White blouse (from Nunes only) with school logo embroidered can only be worn with the Plaid Jumper.

Shorts **must** be worn under skirts and jumpers. Shorts cannot hang below skirts or jumpers. The shorts worn underneath can be any type (biker style, etc.) and do not have to be purchased from Nunes.

ALL STUDENTS:

Shirts: (Nunes Uniform Company only)

Polo Shirts only in Navy Blue with the school logo embroidered on the front.
Polo shirts must be worn at all times.
White or Navy turtlenecks may be worn under the polo shirt **NOT INSTEAD OF** the polo shirts. **Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Waist bands must show.**

Pants: (Nunes Uniform Company only)

Khaki tan color. Pants are not to be too tight or too loose. Pants must be worn at natural waist.

Shorts: (Nunes Uniform Company only)

Khaki tan color. Shorts are not to be too tight or too loose. Shorts must be worn at natural waist. Shorts cannot be any shorter than 3 inches from the kneecap.

Sweatshirts: (Nunes Uniform Company or HCS only)

Only navy blue sweatshirts or sweatshirt jackets with the HCS logo allowed.
No other designs or writings can be on the sweatshirts or sweatshirt jackets.
Sweatshirts and sweatshirt jackets cannot be worn inside out.

Jackets:

Weather permitting, Outdoor jackets are not to be worn in the classroom or the chapel.

Shoes, Socks, Tights:

Socks must be worn at all times.
No sandals, open-toed, open-back or sling back shoes allowed. Tennis shoes are recommended.

No “skate” shoes (heellies) with wheels on bottom.

We recommend tennis shoes. No “skate” shoes (heellies with wheels on bottom).

Hats:

Hats are allowed only for medical purposes with a Doctor’s note.

Hats cannot be worn in the classroom.

Hair:

Hair is to be natural color. Boys must have conservative haircuts with no hair below the nape of the neck or below the ear lobes. Extreme fad styles are left up to the discretion of Administration.

Parents will be called if necessary.

Belts:

Belts must be worn at all times with pants with belt loops for Grades 3rd - 8th.

Belt color must match uniforms. Belts that hang are not allowed.

Other:

Students who wear makeup to school will be asked to wash it off!!

Girls may wear nail polish only if it is a natural color or clear.

Boys are not allowed to wear earrings.

Tattoos are not allowed. (Permanent or Temporary)

No writing is allowed on any clothing, except school emblems or logo.

All clothing must be clean, in good condition, and with no holes.

Earrings can be no longer than ½ inch past the ear lobe for safety reasons.

Chapel Attire: (Chapel is EVERY Wednesday)

Girls must wear their uniform skirts, jumpers or skorts; **NO PANTS.**

Boys must wear uniform long pants; **NO SHORTS.**

FREE DRESS GUIDELINES:

NO FREE DRESS ON WEDNESDAYS.

Clothing must be clean with no holes, rips or tears.

NO oversized or undersized styles. Clothing must not be too tight or too loose.

Frayed and slit bottoms of pant legs are not permitted. Pants must be worn at natural waist.

NO gang connotations.

Skirts, shorts or dresses must be of an appropriate length. No mini lengths.

No tank tops, crop tops, or spaghetti strap tops.

No midriff showing, strapless tops, backless tops, or off the shoulder tops.

ANY logos, pictures, sayings, or connotations on clothing must be appropriate in consideration of our Christian atmosphere.

***REMEMBER - IF IN DOUBT, PACK A UNIFORM.**

Text Book Fees

A 7% discount is offered if you choose to pay the full year tuition by August 15th.

Your tuition is **ALWAYS** due on the 15th day of each month with your first payment due August 15th, and the **last payment will be due June 1st**. Payments must be paid in the school office only. You may pay by cash, check, money order, cashier's check, or credit card. Your entire monthly balance due each month (Tuition, daycare, etc.) must be paid by the 19th of each month to avoid the \$25.00 late fee applied on the 20th of each month. Parents whose accounts are more than 30 days delinquent risk the child's ability to attend class.

If you have a situation arise that will cause you to be late with your payment (which is due on the 15th of each month), please bring a written note to the school office.

LUNCH

Our school has a lunchroom, but not a cafeteria. All children must bring a sack lunch. Facilities are not available for warming food. At lunchtime, white milk, chocolate milk, water, chips, or cookies may only be purchased with either a MILK card, WATER card, or SNACK card. A separate card is needed for white milk, chocolate milk, water, and snacks.

MILK, WATER, AND SNACK CARDS

The cost for a white milk card is \$ 6.00 and \$ 8.00 for a chocolate milk card. A water card is \$20.00 and a snack card is \$ 20.00. Each card is good for 20 purchases. Each card will be punched at the time of use. Cards may be purchased by completing an order form in the school office or you may send a note to the school with your child. We do not accept requests over the telephone. The cost will be added to your monthly bill. Students in grades 5th - 8th will be responsible for their own milk, water, and snack cards.

Your accounts must be paid current to place an order for the milk cards, water cards, or snack cards.

MEDICATIONS

For the protection of all of our students, State Law dictates that if your child needs to take any type of medication (prescription or non-prescription) at school or at any school activities, the parent must fill out and sign a form supplied in the school office. The **child's Doctor** must also fill out and sign the form if the medication is filled by prescription. Medications will not be dispensed unless this form is on file in the office. All medications (prescription or non-prescription, including **COUGH DROPS AND COUGH LOLLIPOPS**) must be left with the office personnel. All medications must be in the original bottle. Prescribed medications must have a label stating dosages and must be prescribed for your child. Students are **NOT** to possess **ANY** type of medication on the school grounds, whether in backpacks, desks, or in lunch pails.

If your child is found with any type of medication in his or her backpack, lunchpail, or seen taking medication on school premises, he or she may be subject to automatic suspension. If a student is found to be sharing any type of medication with another student, this may be cause for expulsion for both students.

STUDENTS CAN BE SUSPENDED AND/OR EXPELLED FOR VIOLATING THIS POLICY.

FUNDRAISERS

Hueneme Christian School does not require mandatory hours of service from our school families. We do, however, have several fundraisers during the school year, in which we request our school families to participate. If the family is unable to participate, a cash donation toward the project is appreciated.

CHAPEL

Each class attends chapel each Wednesday morning. **On chapel days, boys must wear long uniform pants and girls must wear their uniform skirts, jumpers, or skorts; NO SHORTS for boys and girls.** Students participate in our chapel programs with singing and performances. Awards for Student of the Month and Student of the Week are presented. Parents are encouraged to come and observe the chapel programs.

CURRICULUM

Hueneme Christian School uses ABeka, ACSI, and Bob Jones Press Curriculum. The New International Version (NIV) is the standard translation of the Bible that our children use in all classes at Hueneme Christian School.

No other designs or writings can be on the sweatshirts or sweatshirt jackets.

It cannot be worn inside out. Hoods cannot be worn over the head indoors.

Jackets:

Weather permitting, Outdoor jackets are not to be worn in the classroom or the chapel.

Shoes, Socks, Tights:

Socks must be worn at all times.

Leggings or any other type of pants are **NOT** allowed under the skirts/skorts/jumpers.

Tights should match the uniform.

No sandals, open-toed, open-back or sling back shoes allowed.

Tennis shoes are recommended. No "skate" shoes (heellies with wheels on the bottom).

Hats:

Hats are only allowed to be worn on the playground for medical purposes with a Doctor's note.

Hats cannot be worn in the classroom.

Hair:

Hair is to be natural color. Boys must have conservative haircuts with no hair below the nape of the neck, over the eyes, or below the ear lobes. All hair styles will be monitored by Administration. If necessary, parents will be called.

Belts:

Belts must be worn at all times with pants with belt loops for Grades 3rd - 8th. Belt color must match uniforms. Belts that hang are not allowed.

Other:

Students who wear makeup to school will be advised to wash it off!!
Girls may wear nail polish only if it is clear or a natural light **pale** pink.
Boys are not allowed to wear earrings.
Tattoos are not allowed. (Permanent or Temporary)
No writing is allowed on any clothing, except school emblems or logo.
All clothing must be clean, in good condition, and with no holes.
Earrings can be no longer than ½ inch past the ear lobe for safety reasons.

Chapel Attire: (Chapel Attire must be worn EVERY Wednesday)

Girls must wear their uniform skirts, jumpers or skorts; **NO PANTS**.
Boys must wear uniform long pants; **NO SHORTS**.
Uniform shorts are **NOT** allowed on chapel days for boys and girls.

FREE DRESS GUIDELINES AT SCHOOL OR ANY SCHOOL RELATED ACTIVITY/FUNCTION:**NO FREE DRESS ON WEDNESDAYS.**

Clothing must be clean with no holes, rips or tears.

NO oversized or undersized styles. Clothing must not be too tight or too loose.

Frayed and slit bottoms of pant legs are not permitted. Pants must be worn at natural waist.

NO gang connotations.

Skirts, shorts or dresses must be of an appropriate knee length. No mini lengths.

No tank tops, crop tops, or spaghetti strap tops.

No midriff showing, strapless tops, backless tops, or off the shoulder tops.

ANY logos, pictures, sayings, or connotations on clothing must be appropriate in consideration of our Christian atmosphere.
